



THE PHILLIPS FAMILY OF DALLAS COUNTY

William Phillips was born in Wales in 1773. He came to America in 1795 with his brother Philip and an elderly male cousin. They came to the home of another relative in Davidson County, Tennessee. (Mrs. Sally Barnett of Waco, Texas, gr-granddaughter of William, stated she had been told this when a little girl.)

About 1797, William married Nancy Henderson, daughter of William and Jane Henderson, who was born in Maryland, Dec. 25, 1775. She died Sept. 8, 1852 in Larue Co., Kentucky, and is buried in Combs Family Burying Ground near Eagle Mills community. The tombstone gives dates.

William Phillips enlisted in the War of 1812. He was a close friend of Andrew Jackson. There are several references to William in the book "Border Captain" by Marquis James (he is called Lt. Billie Phillips). He made one of the greatest rides of all time from Washington, D. C. to Nashville, Tennessee to announce to the legislature that the United States was at war with England. There are also references to him in "Two Fighters and Two Fines" by Tom Campbell and in "The Life of Andrew Jackson" by Marquis James. On Dec. 20, 1813, he enlisted as 1st Major in the 1st Regiment Mounted (Perkins'), West Tennessee Volunteers for 60 days. He was mustered out Feb. 8, 1814 at Fayetteville, Tennessee. This organization was commanded by Col. Nicholas Perkins in Major General Andrew Jackson's army against hostile Creek Indians.

William is in the 1820 census on Davidson County, Tennessee, but by the 1830 census he was in Hardin Co., Ky. in the part that became Larue County in 1843. After the death of his wife in 1852, William came to Dallas County, Arkansas to visit his sons, Isaac and John B., who had moved there in 1846 with their families, and another son, Madison, who settled in Ouachita County. To his sons back in Kentucky he wrote letters saying he might return, but he lived out his life in Dallas County, dying in November, 1860, and is buried at Hunter's Chapel Cemetery, four miles north of Tulip, Dallas County, Arkansas.

William and Nancy had the following sons, all born in Davidson Co., Tennessee:

2. Isaac Cullen Phillips, born Mar. 19, 1800, Davidson Co., Tenn., died Aug. 16, 1883, Dallas Co., Ark., buried in Hunters Chapel Cemetery. He married Elizabeth Tinker in Hardin Co., Tenn., July 15, 1823. She was the daughter of Dr. Ralph Tinker and wife, Relief Whitney. Dr. Ralph Tinker was the son of Elihu Tinker, Revolutionary War Soldier of Massachusetts. Relief Whitney was the daughter of Eliphalet Whitney, also a soldier in the Revolutionary War. Elizabeth Tinker was born May 5, 1806 in Morristown, Vermont, and died between the 1850 and 1860 censuses in Dallas Co. Their children were:

21. Ralph Phillip Phillips, born June 18, 1824, Kentucky, died Jan. 18, 1902, Dallas Co., Ark., buried Hunters Chapel Cemetery; married Clarissa Ann Elizabeth "Lizzie" Nix, May 31, 1855, by John Amis. She was born May 20, 1835 in Ga., daughter of Nicholas Nix, born 1803 in Ga. The Nix family came to Ark. in 1847 in ox wagons. Both Ralph Phillips and Lizzie (who died Sept. 26, 1912) are buried in Hunters Chapel Cemetery. Their children were:

At the time of his death, Sept. 25, 1922, he had a grocery store, was postmaster at Willow, Ark. As a young man he worked as a cowboy on a ranch on the Brazos River in Texas. Purdy m. Dec. 31, 1885, Mary Sue Heard, b. Nov. 1, 1869, daughter of William Hiram Heard and Tennie Stroud Young. They are buried in Cypress Cemetery, Willow, Dallas Co. They had 12 children:

3. John B. Phillips, third son of William and Nancy (Henderson) Phillips, b. Nov. 6, 1803, Davidson Co., Tenn., d. Sept. 27, 1875, Dallas Co., Ark. He moved with his parents to Hardin Co., Ky. in 1823. When his brother Isaac and family moved to Hardeman Co., Tenn. in 1837, John went with them. He married Mary H. Neely (1811-1893) in 1841, and when Isaac removed to Dallas Co., Ark. in 1846, he moved his family also. His wife brought little cedar trees in dirt, and when set out in a double line in front of their home, they grew and are now a double row of huge trees. John acquired eight slaves, built a large, southern-style home (two-story with front porch columns) on his land six miles west of Sand Springs (now Leola), Arkansas. This house burned Mar. 28, 1945, and was replaced by a white cottage. John and Mary are buried in

Hunters Chapel Cemetery. Mary was the daughter of Major James Neely and wife, Eleanor "Ellen" Phillips, and sister of two famous ministers, Rev. Phillip Phillips Neely and Rev. Thomas Jefferson Neely.

HUNTERS CHAPEL CEMETERY, DALLAS COUNTY, ARKANSAS

Hunters Chapel Cemetery is located on Highway 9 between Lono and Tulip in the northern part of Dallas County, one-half mile south of the Hot Spring County line. The cemetery lies by the side of the Hunters Chapel Methodist Church, organized about 1850 by the Rev. Andrew Hunter. There were no markers placed in the cemetery before 1870, although some of the older graves were marked later. There are many for which no record is available. The first interment on record is that of Nancy Neely Bird, 1830-1853, first wife of William Bird and daughter of Major James Neely and wife, Eleanor Phillips Neely. These records copied from the tombstones by Mrs. Arline Smith Williams, Treasurer and Recorder of Hunters Chapel Cemetery, Route 1, Box 88, Leola, Arkansas.
